Focusing on the global theme - Accelerating Change; Youth4Water Plus with partnership with Sattvic Soul foundation and support from PPL organised World Water Day beach cleaning event "SAVE BLUE LIVE GREEN" to combat climate change and protect our oceans. 200 youths across the state congregated at Gopalpur beach in the Ganjam district of Odisha to sensitise the youths about the plogging which can help fight climate change.



Beach cleaning event, "Save Blue Live Green" was organised on 22nd March at Gopalpur with youth from 3 different campuses Berhampur University, Khallikote College respectively did plogging activity, and took pledge to conserve water and fight against climate change.
